The Department of History organised an educational excursion with the students of Semesters-V & III (Hons) on 7 December 2023. Total 58 students participated in this excursion of which 30 students were from Semester-III and 28 students were from Semester-V. The destinations were Badel, Bansberia, and Pursura. The students visited Radhanagar, Rajbalhat and Atpur. This excursion enriched the students with the art and architectural history of two different periods of Indian History namely pre-colonial and colonial periods. Radhanagar, the birth place of Raj Rammohan Roy enlightened them with the history, architectural and sculptural beauty of the colonial period whereas Rajballavi's Temple at Rajbalhat enriched their knowledge about the charms of art and architecture during pre-colonial period. Atpur associated with the memories of Swami Vivekananda. From this place, Swami Vivekananda started his journey as a monk.
