The Department of History organised an educational excursion with the students of Semesters-V & III (Hons) on 23 November 2022. Total 58 students participated in this excursion of which 25 students were from Semester-III and 33 students were from Semester-V. The destinations were Badel, Bansberia, and Pursura.
