MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING **BETWEEN**

Netaji Mahavidyalaya, Arambagh, Hooghly and Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidya Mahapitha, Kamarpukur, Hooghly, both affiliated to the University of Burdwan, linked by common academic interests, wish to initiate collaborations and exchanges in fields of shared interest and expertise in different disciplines through various programmes supported by the two colleges. Both Netaji Mahavidyalaya & Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidya Mahapitha recognise their strengths and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in Academic, Social & Cultural co-operation. The activities undertaken pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) are based on a spirit of cooperation and reciprocity that is intended to be of mutual benefit of both the institutions.

### Purpose:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) serves as a written understanding of agreed upon principles between Netaji Mahavidyalaya & Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidya Mahapitha concerning a set of general academic objectives. This is a non-binding agreement and is intended to clarify the nature and extent of the harmonizing activities that might be undertaken for the mutual benefit of the two institutions. Each institution will be responsible for managing its own expenses and also sharing the same, when necessary. Commitments of specific institutional resources, personnel, space, facilities, or any other academic or intellectual activities considered hereunder may or may not be beyond the scope of this MOU to the extent that the implementation of any agreed upon activity requires a commitment of resources, personnel, credit-bearing coursework, or intellectual property. A supplementary agreement will be negotiated and approved by the two parties before work on any of the projects can commence.

## 2. Objectives, Scope, and Major Activities:

The goal of this co-operation is to encourage and foster collaboration, provide opportunity for inter college exchange of experience and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts and frequent interactions to promote mutual benefits of both the institutions.

Both the institutions agree to encourage their mutual development by exploring the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaborations.

- Visits and formal exchanges of faculty, scholars and administrators in specific areas
  of education, research and outreach respectively.
- Explore the possibility of training through library as well as laboratory resources.
- Organize joint conferences, symposia, workshop or other scientific meeting on subjects of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information and learning materials.
- Organise cultural competitions and sports meet jointly and exchange students efficient in these spheres.
- Explore the possibilities of developing joint research programs and collaborations.
- Other exchange and cooperation programs such as extension activities to which both the institutions agree.

### 3. Responsibilities of the Institutions:

The two institutions identify that the execution of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the functioning of any exchange and cooperative program based on this MOU shall be conferred and determined between the two institutions. It is also expected that both the institutions will work at per with all the applicable policies of the Govt. of India, State Govt. and University legislations.

# 4. Duration and Option to Amend, Extend or Terminate:

This MOU will become effective from the date on which it is signed by the authorities of both the institutions. The agreement will remain in effect for five years from the date of signature given below, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the institutions. The institutions should agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and to consult concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MOU. Either authority may terminate this MOU at any time by providing written notice of such termination to the other authority, at least 3 months in advance. Once terminated, neither institution will be responsible for any loss, financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer from. However, both the institutions will ensure that all the activities in progress be allowed to complete successfully before termination.

### 5. General Terms:

This MoU is not intended to and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents. Nothing in this MOU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the two parties. Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without written approval of the other party to this MOU.





#### 6. Arbitration clause:

If there be any dispute relating to any aspect of academic and cultural co-operation, Principal/Vice-Principal/TIC of both the colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

### 7. Signatures:

This MOU shall enter into force on the date of the signing by qualified representatives of both the institutions.
